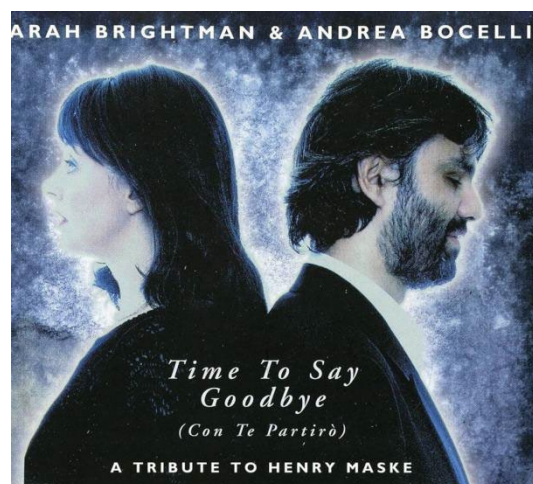


Figure 1 Andrea Bocelli's classic album: *Time to Say Goodbye*
