There are patterns of mandarin ducks playing in the lotus pond, meaning a harmonious relationship between husband and wife. Embroidery pattern of folk fashion is a unique content of Chinese traditional folk culture, which has deep cultural connotation.

In addition, in the costume of the emperor in ancient China, the patterns of embroidery are quite different from those of folk costumes in ancient China, which implies rights and wealth. The patterns of "twelve chapters" of ancient Chinese emperor's costumes are sun, moon, star, dragon, mountain, Chinese worm, fire, Zongyi, algae, rice, square patch on official costume embroidered with white and black axes and square patch on official costume embroidered with cyan and black axes, which all have their own symbolic meanings. Sun, moon and star, three kinds of lights, implying the arrival of light. Dragon, since ancient times, has the meaning of God, representing the status of emperor. Mountain represents the King's demeanor of suppression of the four sides, Chinese worm, the virtue of emperor's articles, Zongyi, the deep and shallow knowledge and power of emperor, fire, emperor's courage to fight, rice, the heroic emperor' ability to support people and reunite his subjects, square patch on official costume embroidered with white and black axes, emperor's consideration for people, square patch on official costume embroidered with cyan and black axes, the emperor and his ministers are united to punish evil. It can be seen that the embroidery of court dress is a symbol of identity and status.

2.2 Traditional Embroidery and National Costume

Different cultural and regional backgrounds will form different embroidery styles and arts. Traditional Miao embroidery is particularly prominent in the embroideries of various nationalities, with its unique national cultural charm. Miao embroidery is often permeated with romantic feelings and love for life, so the color of Miao embroidery is more beautiful and simple with natural form. The bright colors of Miao embroidery costumes often give people unique visual impact. The rich and colorful main tones in large areas are mosaic with small areas of contrast color, which harmonizes and unifies the contrast. Miao embroidery costumes are also very rich and unique in needling techniques, including wrinkle embroidery, stack embroidery and broken silk embroidery, which show the wisdom of the Miao people and their pursuit and yearning for beautiful things. The embellishment of traditional embroidery in national costumes combines the practical value of embroidery with the unique aesthetic appreciation of people of all nationalities, reflecting rich aesthetic interest of all nationalities.
