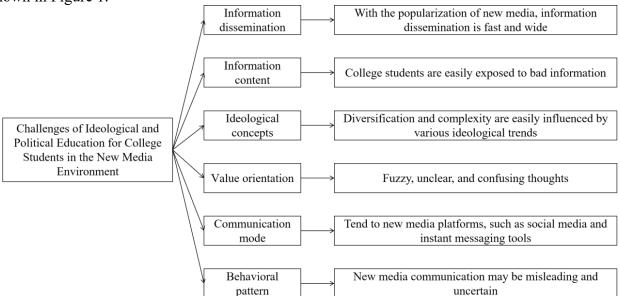


Figure 1 The challenge of IPE under the emerging media environment

Under the emerging media environment, the IPE of university students faces many challenges, as shown in Figure 1.

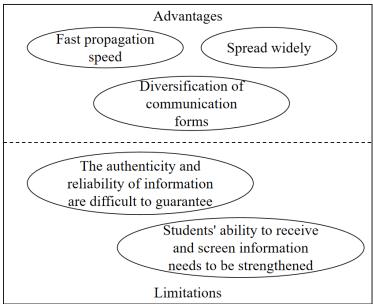


Figure 2 Advantages and limitations of emerging media in educational communication
