


Fig. 1. The Importance of Healthy Psychology to a College Student

Through the questionnaire, we can also see from Figure 1 that 79.5% of college students think that healthy psychology is very important for a college student.

students choose to ask for help from their classmates, and only 11.7% of the teachers who ask for mental health education.




Fig.2. Who is going to ask for psychological problems?
