Many students can't adapt to the new environment very well. But on the other hand, it brings some difficulties to the student management in Colleges and universities, and puts forward new requirements for the work of counselors. At the same time, the management mode of student apartments has gradually changed from school management to social trusteeship. All these make the daily management of counselors more difficult. Therefore, despite a lot of hard work, it seems that young students and young students are always in a state of dissociation, difficult

to penetrate, difficult to enter the students' psychology. Management tools are also limited to positive contacts such as meetings and conversations.
